It costs about \$130 for the 8/9 days. We are allowed in on the Monday morning and must depart by the following Tuesday week. We just bush camp for the first 5

days with camp fires, dampers, jam, pancakes, walks, drives to Coonabarabran and of course gathering and cutting wood. The country music starts Saturday 10am and finishes Sunday about 4pm. There is campfire entertainment of a night on the Thursday/Friday. But really the country music is secondary it's the bush camping and wood-smoke that makes it exciting. We will need to find a "spot" for our club to locate. We will need to decide whether to stay out on the flat grass area or in amongst the trees. So you only need to bring or arrange your own showering facilities. We have attended for the past (4) four years it is fun and very, very different to a NORMAL trip.
