A note from your Editor:

I sent an email to the RMS querying when vehicles towing caravans can stop overnight in RMS Rest Areas and I have received this reply.

In response to your enquiry about overnight camping, Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) advises it does not provide for camping in its rest areas along state highways.

Heavy vehicle rest areas are designed to cater to heavy trucks to have overnight sleep breaks to meet their statutory obligations. However, recreational vehicles such as campervans are not encouraged to treat rest areas as an alternative to caravan parks for extended stays.

This is so that all drivers (both light and heavy vehicle) can access these rest areas for short breaks during their journeys in order to recover from driver fatigue. Drivers are more likely to use rest areas that are not being used for other purposes.

The availability of approved camping grounds can be found by contacting local councils, commercial providers or the Caravan and Camping Industry Association NSW.
