Hi Members,

Rhonda Webb our Secretary received the following from the Roads and Maritime Services, so I thought it would be worthwhile putting in our Newsletter for everyone to read.

#### **Quote**

A letter has been sent to the NSW Association of Caravan Clubs regarding **Wider use of auxiliary number plates**. An auxiliary number plate is an additional number plate issued by Roads & Maritime that can be displayed in some situations when a vehicle's rear number plate is obscured. These changes apply from 1<sup>st</sup> December 2015. Would you mind advising your club members of the following information.

Changes to the vehicle registration regulation now allow auxiliary number plates to be displayed when:

- The rear number plate of the vehicle is obscured by a bicycle, personal mobility device or motorcycle on a rack
- A trailer or caravan number plate is obscured by a bicycle or personal mobility device on a rack
- The rear number plate of the vehicle is obscured by an implement, a vehicle exempt from registration or an unregistered vehicle being towed by the vehicle.
- A trailer number plate is obscured by a boat.

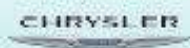
