Hi Members,

Rhonda Webb our Secretary received the following from the Roads and Maritime Services, so I thought it would be worthwhile putting in our Newsletter for everyone to read.

Quote

A letter has been sent to the NSW Association or Caravan Clubs regarding **Wider use of auxiliary number plates.** An auxiliary number plate is an additional number plate issued by Roads & Maritime that can be displayed in some situations when a vehicle's rear number plate is obscured. These changes apply from 1st December 2015. Would you mind advising your club members of the following information.

Changes to the vehicle registration regulation now allow auxiliary number plates to be displayed when:

- The rear number plate of the vehicle is obscured by a bicycle, personal mobility device or motorcycle on a rack
- A trailer or caravan number plate is obscured by a bicycle or personal mobility device on a rack
- The rear number plate of the vehicle is obscured by an implement, a vehicle exempt from registration or an unregistered vehicle being towed by the vehicle.
- · A trailer number plate is obscured by a boat.
