Woolworths Petrol Card: Woolworths will give you a free petrol card that provides you 4c a litre discount. This eliminates the need to run around with Woolies shopper dockets. The best part is that after you have registered online then at your **FIRST** fill up you will receive 10c litre discount. We filled up with 100 litre and received \$10 off. After the first fill the card reverts to 4c discount

NSW CHANGES IN ROAD RULES .

Long vehicles entering and exiting roundabout: A vehicle may now enter and exit a roundabout in either lane or both lanes if all of the conditions below are adhered to:

The vehicle is 7.5 metres or longer (including any load or projections).

The vehicle displays a 'do not overtake turning vehicle' sign.

The vehicle is within 50 metres of the nearest point of the roundabout.

It is not practical for the driver to leave the roundabout more than halfway around it from within the right lane or less than halfway around it from the left lane. Drivers must give way to vehicles entering or exiting the roundabout that are in accordance with this rule.

PENALTY: Two demerit points and a \$189 fine. (*Published June 2008*)

Mobile Phone List: An updated Mobile Phone list was sent out with the June Newsletter. We have had a lot of corrections/changes additions to the

document. At the end of August we will send out hopefully a FINAL correct sheet. So please check your number and any other members number that you know is correct.

How Old Are Your Tyres: How much would it cost to replace your rig if you lost it due to a blowout?. On our recent trip to Beechworth we had a blow out on our van. Whilst the tyre was being replaced at Albury we were advised that although the tyres had only travelled 1000k in 4-5 years they were deemed to be too old and should be replaced anyway. On NBN ACA show on the 14/5/2008 the Editor of Wheels Magazine presented a story about tyres. I spoke to a friend in the business and he confirmed that he also caught the program and agreed with everything that was said. To tell the age of a tyre look for a group of numbers stamped on the side wall. Looking at three different examples say 2406, 1404 and 189 and they mean respectively the 24th week of 2006, the 14th week of 2004, and 18th week of 1999. This last example (189) is a nine year old tyre and this tyre should be replaced immediately. This really includes any tyre that is more than 4 years old. The tyre stamped 1404 is also on the borderline for replacement. Over time the rubber will dry out and go hard and then when used at highway speeds will generate enough heat to destroy itself. (ie;cause a blow out). It was stated that any tyre over 4 years old regardless of condition should be replaced NOW. It was also stated that it is illegal to sell and fit second hand tyres. But if purchased from a dealer say Bob Jane or similar organization the tyre would have been inspected and deemed road worthy if offered for sale and this practice is NOT considered illegal. *Ken Cooper*
